Awards will be given to the top 3 male/female finishers in the 3 mile, 6 mile and half marathon trail runs.

Location and Course

To honor Ray's spirit of strength and kindness, we have organized the annual 'Run For Ray' trail run. The run format consist of the following course options:

- One 3 mile trail loop
- One 6 mile trail loop
- 13 mile trail run (2 loops)

The terrain is technical, hilly and the trail can be very challenging in spots. Aid stations will be at various locations along the course with water available.

The run will begin near the parking lot of the gazebo in the Brunswick Nature Park. Race morning registration and packet pick up will be under the gazebo and will begin at 7:00 am. We cannot guarantee t-shirts for participants that register the morning of the event.

I pledge to obey the rules of the USA Track & Field. *USATF sanction number*:12-13-002 **Waiver of Refund:** I acknowledge that my registration fee and other fees will not be refunded for any reason. **Waiver of Liability:** I fully appreciate and assume the risks of participating on an open course that has objects such as roots, branches, other vegetation, mud, and water on the trail that may cause me to fall. The terrain is hilly and the trail is challenging. Fallen leaves conceal rocks, roots, sticks, and holes. Expect to trip and fall at least once during the day. If you turn an ankle, keep moving. I assume all risks associated with running in the event, including but not limited to falls, contact with other participants, the effects of weather, road & trail conditions, all such risks being known and appreciated by me, I realize that this is a strenuous event which requires physical conditioning. I am physically fit for the event I enter. I authorize event officials to provide medical attention at my expense, should I appear in need. For injuries that I sustain, including death, I give up for myself and my heir and other acting on my behalf or my estate's behalf all claims against race organizers, sponsors, local governments, enforcement personnel, volunteers, race staff, suppliers, contractors and anyone else connected with organization of the event.

Ray Underhill spent the last two years battling a chordoma brain tumor. Despite the conditions debilitating effects, Ray maintained the kindness and strength he was known for. He was an example to his family and to his friends of what it means to be a father, a husband, and a friend. Throughout his ordeal, Ray never let his spirit succumb to the cruelty of the condition.

Ray will be remembered by some as a Powell-Peralta Bones Brigade pro skateboarder of the late 80's with the smooth style and deep bag of tricks. By others in the skateboard industry, as the Gullwing team manager or web master at Eastern Skateboard Supply. To those who knew Ray, he is remembered as the guy we wish everyone else would emulate. Ray's kindness, candor and his sense of humor should be an example to follow. If everyone in the world were just a little more like Ray, what an amazing peaceful place this would be.

Ray was born October 18, 1962, in Nashville, TN. He relocated to California in the mid 80's to become a pro skateboarder. He married Kerry on September 5, 1992 and became a father when Keaton was born in 1995. They moved to Wilmington, NC in 1998 and worked for Eastern Skateboard Supply. His daughter, Olivia, was born in 2000. He was a volunteer at Ogden Elementary School. He was known worldwide and loved by all. He was a loving husband, father, son, brother and friend.

After surgery, and several radiation and chemotherapy treatments, Ray passed away on Friday morning, August 1st, 2008 at a hospital near his home...
